The regulations of “KURLAND TROPHY 2008”
“4X4 EURO CHAMPIONSHIP 2008” 4th series and
Latvia’s trophy-raid championship 5th series.

1. PROGRAMME.

1.1. “4X4 EURO CHAMPIONSHIP 2008” 4th series and
Latvia’s trophy-raid championship 5th series (hereafter championship) will take place in rural
Municipalities of Ēdoles, Ziru and Alsungas, District of Kuldīga, Latvia from 10th to 12th
October 2008.

1.2. Championship is in compliance with 4X4 EURO CHAMPIONSHIP 2008 regulations, national sports code of LAF (Latvia's Automobile Federation), Latvia's trophy-raid championship 2008 regulations and these regulations.

2. ORGANIZATION COMITEE.

Championship is organized by society «Mazozoli 4x4» - Latvia.

Championship director – Jānis Lazdāns

Event commissars - Jānis Zaremba, Gabriels Žīgurs. (LV) and Audrius Sutkus (LT).

General referee – Aivars Sprukts.

Technical commissar – Māris Podiņš.

Participants referee – Brunis Lielkāja

3. PARTICIPANTS VEHICLES AND EQUIPMENT .

3.1 Any person who is at least 16 years old has the right to participate in championship, the driver must have a drivers license category allowing him to drive the vehicle he has chosen. Only participants with this year's sports license handed out by LAF will receive points for Latvia's trophy-raid championship 2008. Single occasion license can be purchased during the enrollment.

3.2 Latvia's trophy-raid championship 2008 vehicle categories:

- "TR1" – individual teams driving automobiles that correspond to TR1 technical specifications;
- "TR2" – individual teams driving automobiles that correspond to TR2 technical specifications;
- "TR3" – individual teams driving automobiles that correspond to TR3 technical specifications;
- "Open" – individual teams driving automobiles that correspond to OPEN technical specifications;

- ATV (quadricycles) drivers team up in teams of two.

3.3 4X4 EURO CHAMPIONSHIP 2008 vehicle categories;

- "TR1" – individual teams driving automobiles that correspond to TR1 technical specifications;
- "TR2" – individual teams driving automobiles that correspond to TR2 technical specifications;
- "TR3" – individual teams driving automobiles that correspond to TR3 technical specifications;
- ATV Original;
- ATV open.

ATV drivers team up in teams of two.

3.4 Equipment.

Alimentary and water reserve for minimum 9 hours for each of the teams members.

Warm clothes.

Digital photo camera with a memory card or USB cable.

GPS, laptop (recommended).

Orange, light reflecting vest for each member of the team.

Every vehicle has to have a power outlet of 12V required to power track control device.

Checkpoint coordinates are handed out in two ways :

a) Written on the message board,

b) Copied to your USB flash memory device during the enrollment. Other memory devices such as GPS equipment and laptops are not accepted!

4. Navigation.

4.1 Total distance of the Championship ~250 km or ~ 15 hours.

4.2 The task of participants is to accomplish the route with the help of the roadbook and map in the given time and to find and reach with their vehicles all the given checkpoints.

5. RESPONSIBILITY AND SAFETY

5.1 Championship is held in accordance with the Traffic Rules of Latvia. Participants are responsible for any harm the cause to themselves, other participants or other persons.

5.2 By submitting the application form for Championship participants confirm that they are acquainted with the 4X4 EURO CHAMPIONSHIP 2008, Latvia's trophy-raid championship 2008 regulations and KURLAND TROPHY 2008 regulations, has no complaints about these regulations and agrees to strictly follow them.

6. APPLICATIONS AND PARTICIPANT FEES.

6.1. Participant fee for all the automobile categories is 70 LVL or 100 EUR, Participant fee for quadricycles are 35 LVL or 50 EUR per participant. Applications must be sent in till 6th of October.

6.2. If the applications are sent in after the 6th of October participant fee is 85 LVL or 120 EUR.

6.4. In case of enrolment delay, within 1hour, additional Ls 10LVL or 15 EUR are added to the fee.

6.5. **Safety deposit of 100 LVL or 140 EUR has to be deposited for each vehicle**, this sum will be returned at the end of Championship. Deposit is not returned if handed out equipment is not returned, the participants do not inform the referees about their retirement, if there is damage done to the environment or property.

6.7. 7. PROTESTS AND APPEALS.

Protests and appeals are to be lodged in compliance with 4X4 EURO CHAMPIONSHIP 2008 regulations, national sports code of LAF (Latvia's Automobile Federation), and Latvia's trophy-raid championship 2008 regulations. Safety deposit of 300 EUR has to be deposited for each protest.
