



'Vasalemma Offroad Rally 2022' off-road vehicle endurance race rules

1. Definition of races and organiser

1.1. The off-road vehicles endurance race 'Vasalemma Offroad Rally 2022' is being organised by the NGO Ragnar Off-Road House from 10-12 June 2022 in accordance with the general rules of the Off-road Racing Estonia Championship, the EAL Estonia 4x4 Off-Road Track Racing rules, the EAL Estonia 4x4 Off-Road Circuit Cup Competition rules, the EAL Estonia 4x4 Off-Road Super Cup competition general rules and technical requirements and these competition rules. The competition is registered with the EAL: reg. no. 45/OR.

All people involved in the organisation and running of the rally will wear a blue vest and a neon green wristband bearing Vasalemma Offroad Rally imagery.

2. General definitions

2.1. In the course of the 'Vasalemma Offroad Rally 2022', the rank order in the main race will be determined for the following vehicle classes: ET1; ET2; TR-1; VEOK; ATV; ATV free; UTV; and Enduro motorcycles.

Series competitions

2.2. 'Vasalemma Offroad Rally 2022' is the second race in the Off-road Racing Estonia Championship for the competition classes ET1 and ET2.

2.3. 'Vasalemma Offroad Rally 2022' is the second race in the EAL Estonia 4x4 Off-Road Track Racing Championship for the competition classes ATV, ATV FREE, TR-1 and VEOK.

2.4. 'Vasalemma Offroad Rally 2022' is the third race of the 2022 EAL Estonia 4x4 Off-Road Super Cup.

3. General description of competition track

3.1. The race will take place on the Vasalemma rallycross track in Vasalemma, Lääne-Harju municipality, Harju County, Estonia (59.23514, 24.2859).

3.2. For all off-road vehicles, VEOKs and ATV FREE classes, the competition will be held in two stages: Stage I being time trials and Stage II being the main race on the off-road racing track. Enduro motorcycles, UTVs and ATVs will start in the competition in Stage II: the main race on the off-road racing track.

3.3. The racing track is designed for all-terrain and off-road vehicles. The track is the same for all competition classes in the main part.

3.4. Time trials take place in the same competition area, but may not overlap with the main track.

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3.5. The total length of the track is approximately 5 km. 90% of the track is observable around and within the race centre (in designated safe areas) and the remaining 10% of the track is located in the forest and meadow. The track has ascents of varying degrees of difficulty, as well as rock-climbing (Trial), additional obstacles and Jokker; additionally, there are some descents. There are also natural and specially created clay and mud sections. In addition, the track includes water obstacles and faster trick sections for all competition classes. The entire track is technically complex and Offroad Rally is fast-paced, challenging and adrenaline-packed for drivers.

4. Competition classes

- 4.1. Off-road vehicles: ET1 and ET2 – in accordance with the EAL 4x4 AK OR EMV technical requirements; TR-1 – in accordance with the EAL 4x4 AK technical requirements.
- 4.2. ATV and ATV FREE – in accordance with the EAL 4x4 AK technical requirements.

As a minimum, the driver’s equipment must comply with the requirements of EAL4X4AK . See: offroad.ee/tehnilised-tingimused/voistleja-kohustuslik-varustus-atv-voistlusklassides

- 4.3. Enduro – motorcycles must be in proper technical condition.

As a minimum, the driver’s equipment must comply with the requirements of EAL4X4AK . See: offroad.ee/tehnilised-tingimused/voistleja-kohustuslik-varustus-atv-voistlusklassides

- 4.4. VEOK – in accordance with the EAL 4x4 AK technical requirements for trucks.
- 4.5. UTV – competition vehicles must be in proper technical condition.

5. Terms and conditions of participation

5.1. Documents required from teams:

5.1.1. Competition classes ET1, ET2 and TR-1:

- Driver’s licence (pilot);
- Valid traffic insurance policy and technical inspection are not mandatory, excluding TR-1;
- EAL driver’s licence or 4x4 licence issued by the national motorsport federation of the country of residence – all competitors in a competition vehicle;
- The vehicle’s registration certificate;
- Copy (online bank printout) of the payment order proving payment of the participation fee.

5.1.2. ET2 – Estonian competitors – technical card of EAL competitor’s vehicle.

5.1.3. Competition classes VEOK, Enduro; ATV; UTV:

- A driver’s licence for the vehicle in the relevant category;
- The vehicle’s registration certificate;
- E4x4KV competitors must have an EAL driver’s licence or a 4x4 licence issued by the national motorsport federation of the country of residence;
- Copy (online bank printout) of the payment order proving payment of the participation fee.
- *In motorsports competitions, the valid accident insurance coverage is at least 3300 euros. In its absence, you must purchase a one-off insurance policy arranged by the organisers on site.*

5.2. All teams must present themselves at the competition office, where the team’s details and conditions for registration will be verified and the team added to the competition’s management system. A participator card is issued at the competition office. The participator card is duplicative and informative in nature, bearing important information for competitors. Checks can be marked on the card, such as passing technical inspection; in addition, time trial results can be added to it. The participator card must be presented in accordance with the start referee’s orders. At other times it must always be in the competition vehicle.

5.3. **The maximum number of team members in classes ET1 and ET2 is three.** The team members must be older than 16; no gender or other age restrictions apply. Team members’ details are submitted to the organisers on the registration form. The team members and their number can only be changed for good reason and with the organiser’s permission.

5.4. Each competition vehicle must bear a competition number that allows the vehicle to be identified on the track. See www.offroad.ee/voistlusnumbrid

Any issues involving competition numbers must be resolved by the technical committee. The team is responsible for ensuring that the competition number is legible for referees throughout the competition.



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- 5.5. The competition office provides all race vehicles with a timekeeping transponder, which is attached to the vehicle by the technical committee. (We ask that you create suitable conditions in advance for attaching the transponder.) If a competitor loses or breaks the timekeeping transponder, the team is obliged to compensate the organiser for the damage to the device (by paying a fine of 350 euros). After leaving the track, the transponder must immediately be returned to the timekeeping judge.
- 5.6. All competitors must adhere to the rules determined in the EAL documents, these competition rules and the rules of the competitors' camp and behave respectfully towards fellow competitors and those involved in organising the competition. Ignoring this rule may result in a fine or disqualification for a certain period (see Clause Penalties).
- 5.7. All team pilots must confirm with their signature that they will adhere to all competition rules and not damage the environment and that they have examined and understood the competition instructions. The pilot (i.e. the competitor who gave their signature in regard to the restrictions and requirements listed in the previous clause) is responsible for violations and the ignoring of the requirements due to the behaviour of team members.
- 5.8. During the competition, damage caused to third parties and fellow competitors shall be compensated by the team which caused the damage.
- 5.9. **Helmet use is compulsory in all classes in the time trial and main race, in accordance with the EAL 4x4 AK rules 'Helmet requirements and wearing of helmets'.**
- 5.10. All competitors take to the track at their own responsibility.
- 5.11. The competition organiser and EAL shall not be responsible for material and moral damage caused by the teams to themselves or third parties.

6. Registration and participation fees

- 6.1. Pre-registration is open online until 23:59 on 8 June 2022 by filling in the registration form at offroad.ee/registreerimine-voistlustele. A team is deemed registered once the participation fee has been received in the bank account of the organiser.
- 6.2. Participation fees
- 6.2.1. **The following participation fees apply when registering for the competitions and paying the participation fee by 23:59 on 8 June 2022:**
- Competition classes ET1 and ET2 – €120
 - Competition classes ATV, ATV FREE and UTV – €80
 - Competition class Enduro – €65
 - Competition class VEOK – €80
 - Competition class TR-1 – €100
- The rental fee of the timekeeping transponder is included in the participation fee.*
- 6.2.2. **The organiser also provides a bonus: all teams in the ET1, ET2, TR-1, VEOK, ATV, ATV FREE, ENDURO and Turist competition classes will receive an official 'Vasalemma Offroad Rally 2022' T-shirt. The T-shirts are included in the participation fee!**
- The only condition is that the desired sizes (S, M, L, XL, etc.) be marked on the registration form along with an indication of gender (e.g. Men's L or Women's S).
- Each team will be able to obtain the T-shirts from the competition office. Others can purchase the T-shirts and other mementos from the secretariat on site.
- Pre-ordering by e-mail and paying on site is also possible: ragnar@offroadhouse.ee
- Note: **The discount applies when paying the participation fee by 23:59 on 31 May 2022.**
- 6.2.3. **When registering for the competition and paying the participation fee on the spot, a late fee of 50 euros applies.**
- The rental fee of the timekeeping transponder is included in the participation fee.*
- Note: The order in which participation fees are paid and registration forms are filled in for Enduro motorcycles will determine the actual starting order of competitors in the competition class.*
- Pre-registered competitors must pay the participation fee by bank transfer by 23:59 on 8 June 2022 to the bank account of the NGO Ragnar Off-Road House. The payer must note the name of the team (the competitor's name and class designation and the particular competition classes), the competition class and the competition number on the payment order.

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Note: When paying, ensure that the payment is received on time and by the correct recipient. Be sure to keep a copy of the payment order. If you would like an invoice to be issued to your company, e-mail info@offroadhouse.ee with your company's details in good time, or contact the organiser.

6.3. From 9 June (for information on site call +372 50 26 098) it will be possible to register and pay the participation fee at the competition venue by card, cash or bank transfer (see clause 6.2.3: participation fees).

6.4. A team from which a correctly filled-in registration form has been received and the participation fee paid according to the registration conditions shall be deemed registered. (It is recommended that international competitors contact the organisers early in respect of payment of the participation fee and specify the procedure for doing so.)

6.5. The above-mentioned payments apply to competitors who agree to display the organiser's advertisements on their competition vehicle. If the competitor refuses to accept the organiser's advertisements, by adding a note to this effect to the participation form, 200 euros is added to the above-specified payments. Advertisements related to the competition sign and competition number cannot be refused.

6.6. The participation fee shall not be reimbursed to teams who do not show up for the competition.

7. Competition programme

7.1. Registration and competition office

7.1.1. Pre-registration is open until 23:59 on 8 June 2022.

7.1.2. You can register and obtain your credentials on site on:

7.1.2.1. 10 June (16:00-20:00)

7.1.2.2. 11 June (9:00-20:00)

7.1.2.3. 12 June (credentials: call +372 50 90 585 at least 12 hours in advance).

7.1.3. In the event of long queues, the organiser may extend the registration and competition office hours. If there are no teams waiting to be registered, the organiser's representative may not be in the competition office. Information on registration and credentials can be obtained from the information board next to the competition office.

7.1.4. Registration and credentials must be completed by all competitors at least three hours before the start of a respective competition class.

7.1.5. Operating hours of technical inspection:

10 June: 13:00-18:00

11 June: 9:00-12:00 and 14:00-17:00

12 June: as necessary (conducted with at least 12 hours' notice by calling +372 52 32 468).

7.2. Start schedule:

17:00-21:00 Competition classes TR-1, ET1 and ET2 time trials.

7.2.2. Saturday 11 June

9:00 – Assignment of competitors' start positions and meeting – **TR-1 and UTV.**

12:30 – Assignment of competitors' start positions and meeting – **ET1 and ET2.**

13:00 – ET1 and ET2 start – 3 hrs

17:00-19:00 Time trials of VEOK, ATV and Enduro competition classes

19:30 – Awards ceremony

7.2.3. Sunday 12 June

9:00 – Assignment of competitors' start positions and meeting – **ATV and ATV VABA.**

9:30 – ATV and ATV VABA start – 2 hrs

9:30 – Assignment of competitors' start positions and meeting – **Enduro.**

10:00 – Enduro start – 1.5 hrs

12:30 – Assignment of competitors' start positions and meeting – **VEOK.**

13:00 – VEOK start – 2 hrs

16:00 – Awards ceremony
